SPECTATORS INFORMATION FOR TERM 3 Spectators are welcome in our limited space. In order to maximise safety-

(1) sit in the spectator area to the right of the entry door.

(2) remain in your seat for the duration of your child's class – do not leave via the front doors

(3) turn your mobile to silent so as not to disrupt other spectators

The front doors are kept locked when there is no one available to monitor entry and exit. This protects the safety of all on the premises, reduces the chances of vandalism and theft and also minimises disruption to coaches and assistants.
