## **SPECTATORS INFORMATION**

(3) turn your mobile to silent so as not to disrupt other spectators

The front doors are kept locked so that entry can be monitored, to protect the safety of all on the premises and to assist coaches and assistants. We ask that once spectators are in the hall, that they stay inside and do not go out the front doors.

Masks are advised at times due to the difficulty in maintaining safe social distancing.
